About the Institution:

Established in the year 1887, Nizam College came into existence through the amalgamation of Hyderabad School (Noble School) and Madrasa-I-Aliya. The College was established during the reign of Mir Mahbub Ali Khan, Asaf Jah VI, in Basheerbagh, Hyderabad, Telangana. Initially the college was under the Madras University; Nizam College became a constituent college of Osmania University in 1947. It is spread in 20.47 acres with sprawling grounds. Nizam College has 33 departments and it offers 24 UG and 21 PG programmes;

Three Certificate, five Diploma, one PG Diploma and ten departments have Ph.D. supervisors guiding PhD research scholars. Autonomous status was conferred for undergraduate courses in 1988-89, awarded the status of College with Potential for Excellence (CPE), Star College Scheme by the D.B.T. in 2009, MHRD - UGC BSRG Phase I and II and funded by DST-FIST programme. The college has Career Guidance cell, Placement cell, Psychological counselling center, Women cell, Biodiversity club, Butterfly house and many more which aid in all round development of the student.

About the Department:

The Department of Zoology, Nizam College is as old as the College itself, being one of the first Departments to sciences at undergraduate level. Postgraduate course was started in the year 1980.
