History

Established in 1887 by the amalgamation of Hyderabad School and the Madarsa-i- Aliya, Nizam College is one of the oldest and most esteemed institutions of higher education in South India. It was affiliated to the University of Madras for 60 years after its inception, and was made a Constituent College of Osmania University on 19th February 1947. Dr. Aghornath Chattopadhyay , father of Sarojini Naidu, was the founder Principal of the College . The college was first granted Autonomous Status for Undergraduate Courses by the UGC in 1988-89 and has already completed 28 successful years of autonomy. The College was reaccredited by NAAC with A grade in Feb 2012.

Academic Facilities

Equal Opportunity Cell : This cell was established in the year 2013. Its primary objective is to enable the BC, SC, ST & Minority Students of the college to enter 'Entry Level Services' at State and Central Governments. It arranges free coaching classes for these students for different competitive examinations. The Cell in collaboration with the Placement Cell, ELTC and Dept. of English conducted sessions on English for competitive exams, Resume Writing and Interview Skills. Many students of the College including physically and visually challenged got benefited of this Cell and got selected as Probationary Officers, Clerks for different Banks and other State services.

Cell for Differently Aabled : A separate Cell is formed in 2014 to provide equal status for the disabled students of the college. This Cell supports them to prove their skills on par with the able students. This Cell is a first of its kind in the Osmania University. The college procured five computers with Screen Reader Software for the benefit of Visually challenged. It acquired a Brailee Reader Machine. It also undertook conversion of basic text books into e-format, with the support of EFLU, Hyderabad.

The Cell has registered itself with book share. Book share consists of thousands of books under various categories which can be downloaded by the students free of cost. It also procured books for UPSC exams with the help of L V Prasad Eye Institute, Hyderabad.

ELTC : This Center is conducting various training classes to hone the skills of Communicative English. It conducts English for competitive exams & Remedial English Classes for UG and PG students. The Center in collaboration with Placement Cell & EOC conducted a preparatory programme for UG and PG students.

Career Guidance, Training and Placement Center : This Center plays pivotal role in empowering the students with training sessions on Employability Skills. The Center organized placement drives and played crucial role in the selection of 100 UG Students & 70 PG students in various organizations like WIPRO, HGS, ADP, Cognizant, MRF & South Indian Bank. UG & PG students got internship with SBH, Yamaha, IDBI. The Center conducted a Two week course on Communication Skills & Soft skills for MCA Students in Collaboration with Dept of English.

Foreign Students Wing : Our College has good number of global students on the campus. The College has 1048 foreign students from 65 various nations. The college conducted "International Foreign Students Day", showcasing their socio-cultural skills. College also conducted Intra University Foreign Students Sports Meet in Jan-2015 in collaboration with Sports Coaching Foundation, O.U.

Womens Cell : This Cell is doing exemplary work to uphold the dignity Safety & Security respect of the girl students, women staff of teaching and non-teaching . It conducted programmes to promote equality. It organized various socio-cultural events, academic programmes to empower and instill confidence in them, in this fast progressing era. The Cell celebrates International Women's Day every year.

Sports & Games: Students have won many championships by leaps and bounds. This department is keeping up the legacy of sports by promoting and providing better facilities.

A Multi- Station gymnasium costing Rs.1 lakh has been installed in the newly constructed sports complex. The vast campus of the College has play grounds for Cricket, Volley Ball, Basket Ball, Shuttle, Hockey, Kabbadi, Foot Ball, Korf Ball and facilities for indoor games like Table Tennis, Chess, etc. This is the only college in the twin cities to have such facilities other than the O.U. Campus. The department conducts various events both at the College and Inter-college level. The Performance of College sportsmen was outstanding in cricket and knockout tournaments conducted by Hyderabad Cricket Association.

NCC : This unit got so many feathers to its cap. The students contingent is marching ahead with more vigour and valour towards the safety and security of the nation. It has two hundred highly disciplined, dedicated and courageous cadets with a special group of girl cadets. It is led by ANO Lt. Mr. T. Gangadhar. Cadets took part in Youth Exchange Program at Nepal, RDC, Thal Sainik Camp(TSC), Special National Camps held at New Delhi, ATC, Kakinada and LRDC Camps. Our cadets won 8 Gold, 7 Silver, 3 Bronze medals in various State and National Events .

NSS : Nizam College has three strong units with more than 300 volunteers headed by 3 NSS Program Officers , Dr. Ch. Vamseedhar, Dr. G. Upender Reddy & Dr. K. Srinivas. This Cell strives to inculcate the sense of service among its volunteers towards the society and the nation. The Unit leaves no stone unturned in its mission of Nation building. CHIOCE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

Nizam College has introduced Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for all the Undergraduate courses from the academic year 2015-16. The CBCS pattern enhances the academic standards and the quality in Higher education by improving the Teaching-Learning process, Examination-Evaluation systems and Governance. As per the UGC guidelines the College offers foundation courses and elective courses, apart from Core courses (Optional subjects) in all the UG Programmes (B.A./B.Com./B.Sc.). College has adopted the Absolute Grading System in which the marks are converted to grades, based on the pre-determined class intervals.

The salient features of CBCS pattern at Nizam College are:

- (i) In the I and II Semesters of all the Programmes, Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) a) Environmental Science and b) Moral Values & Ethics are offered.
- (ii) In Semester III a generic elective with a combination of multi-disciplines is offered under Skill Enhancement Course (SEC). The course consists of four units Communicative Business Skills, e-banking, Telangana History and Health & Wellness.
- (iii) In Semester IV an Open elective may be chosen from the unrelated discipline, under Skill Enhancement Course (SEC).
- (iv) In Semester V the Discipline Specific Elective (DSC) is offered in which the student may choose either of the Core subject electives E1/ E2.
- (v) In the Semester VI, project work is adopted under Discipline Specific Electives (DSC).
- (vi) The AECC and SEC in the first four Semesters are given 2 credits each.
- (vii) NCC/NSS/Games & Sports and other activities are assessed for 2 credits.
- (viii) The average attendance of all Semesters of the student is assessed for 2 credits.
- (ix) The overall credits for the Core courses, Discipline Specific Courses (DSC) and Discipline Specific Elective (DSC), Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and others are 120.
