Sir/Madam,

The Special Chief Secretary of Education, Govt. of T.S. Hyderabad through letter cited has instructed the Universities to direct the Colleges under the respective jurisdiction for reopening of all the Under-Graduate, Post-Graduate & Professional Colleges from 1st February, 2021, by following the COVID-19 guidelines issued by the Government.

Accordingly, the University has decided to implement the guidelines of the Government of Telangana for reopening of all the Colleges for the Final year students of UG, PG & Professional programs with effect from 1st February, 2021 in the following lines.

1. To reopen the Colleges both at UG/PG & Professional level only to the students of Final semester/year with effect from 1st February, 2021, mandatorily following SOP-COVID-19 guidelines.
2. The Colleges offering Engineering course to reopen for the third & final year students only.
3. To obtain an undertaking from the students/parents stating that they have tested negative for COVID-19 and they would follow all the COVID-19 guidelines as prescribed by the Government for prevention of COVID-19. The Undertaking should be supported with the medical certificate in a prescribed format.
4. To conduct interactive sessions and practical's during the month of February, 2021 followed by semester exams in the month of March,2021 to all the students of final semester.
5. Minimum attendance will not be required for appearing in the examinations of the current semester of the academic year 2020-2021.
6. The maximum of 50% classrooms capacity strength shall be permitted to attend Physical classes on rotational basis.

7. No decision is taken on reopening of the Hostels and Messes.

Therefore it is to inform that, all the Principals of the Campus, Constituent & Affiliated colleges are allowed to re-open from **1st February, 2021** mandatorily following the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) of COVID -19, as per Government of India.
