- 1. **Curriculum Development and Review**: Ensuring that the curriculum is regularly updated and aligned with current educational trends and industry requirements, while also introducing new programs and courses through collaboration with academic and industry experts.
- Faculty Development Programs: Organizing workshops, seminars, and training sessions to enhance teaching methodologies, promote research, and encourage professional development of faculty members.
- 3. **Student Support and Welfare**: Initiatives focused on improving student engagement, mental health, career guidance, and creating an inclusive environment. This includes counselling services, extracurricular activities, and leadership training programs.

- Technology Integration: Promoting the integration of modern technologies in teaching and learning, such as digital classrooms, e-learning tools, and data analytics to enhance educational outcomes.
- 9. Quality Enhancement Initiatives: Regular monitoring and evaluation of academic programs, teaching methods, and student performance. This can include revising assessment methods and ensuring the development of soft skills alongside academics.
