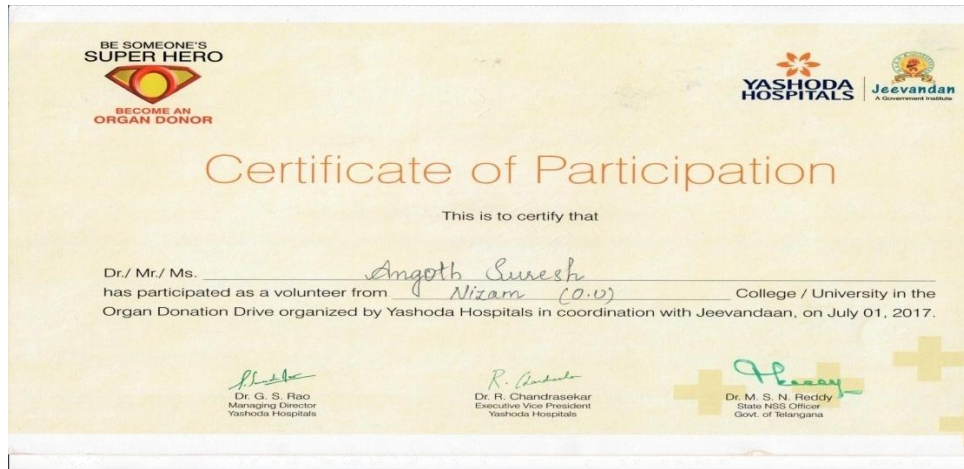
Unveiling Longest National Flag - 2nd October, 2015

A. Suresh participated in Pre-Republic Day Parade camp from 2nd to 11th November, 2016 at Maharaja Sayaji Rao University, Baroda.

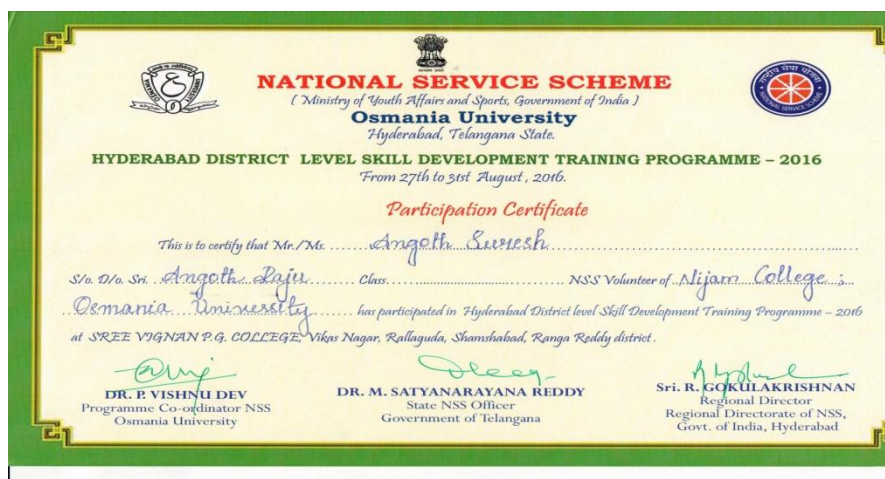


Harithaharam - 7th July 2016

District level Skill Development Training Program - 27th to 31st August, 2016 at Sree Vignan College, Shamshabad, R.R. District, Hyderabad

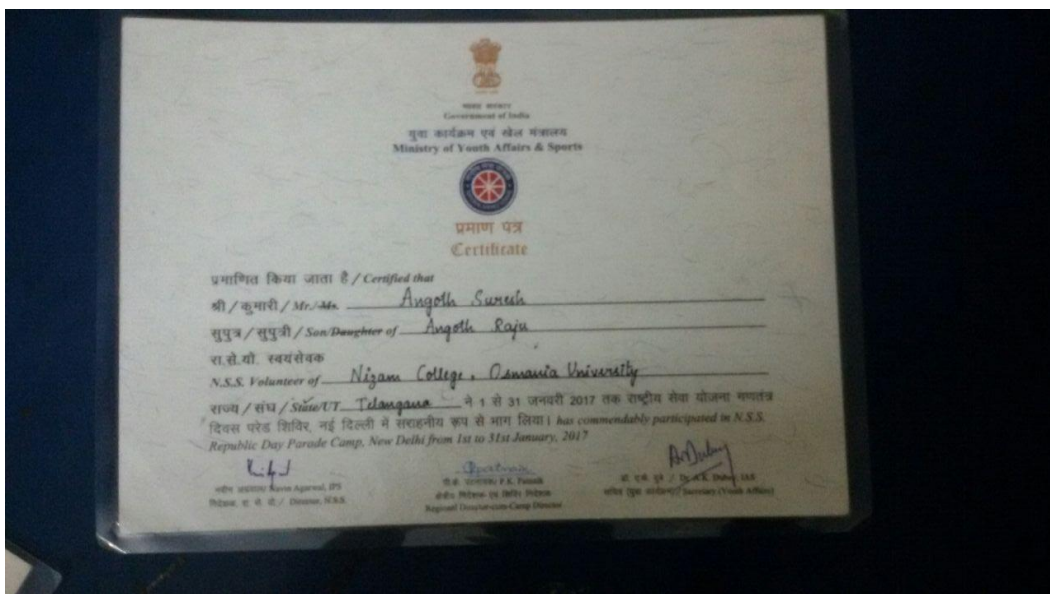

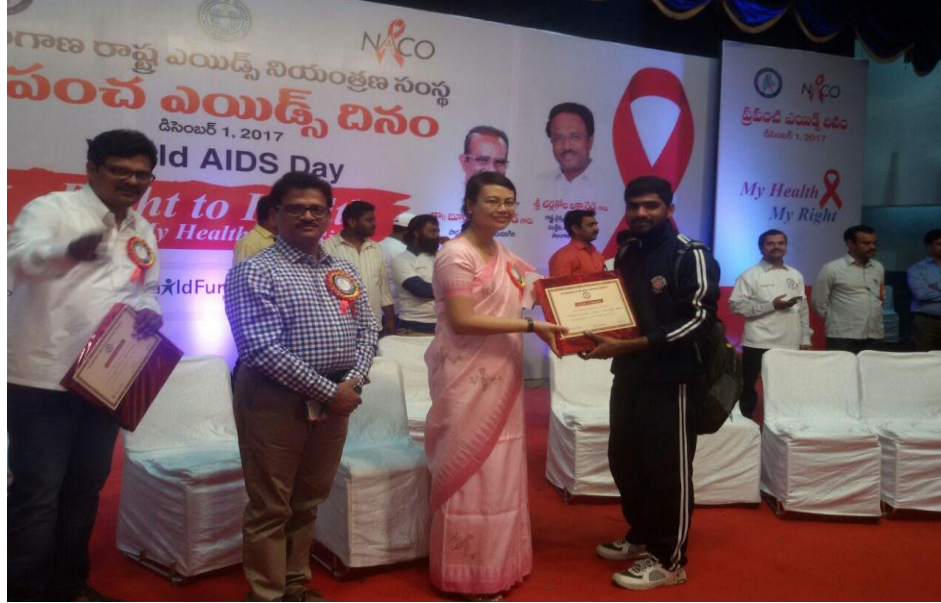
WOW - NSS Mega Green Camp - 2016 - 2017 held from 2-1-2017 to 9-1-2017

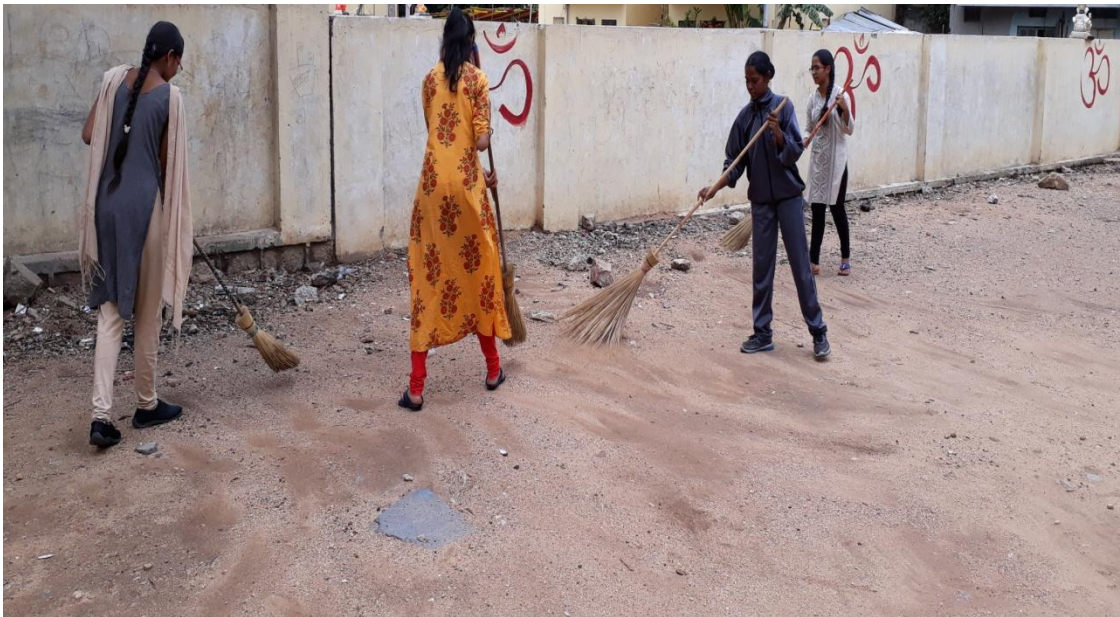
SWACHH BHARAT SUMMER INTERNSHIP (SBSI) 2019

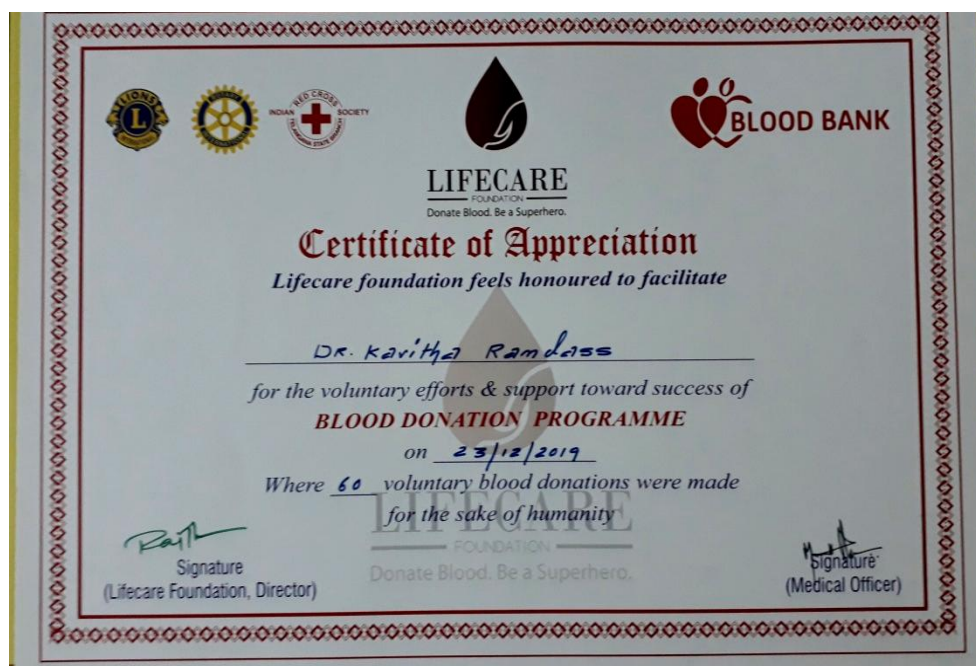
World Aids Day on 1st December, 2019

First day 04-02-2020

On the first day of the NSS camp at Khanapur village, Manchala (Mandal), Ranga Reddy (Dist) 50 NSS volunteers along with Programme officer, Unit - III, Dr. Kavitha Ramdas reached the village by bus in the morning. All the volunteers introduced themselves and their interests towards service. She also gave a brief introduction about Khanapur village (Ibrahimpatanam). Later all volunteers gathered at the old gram panchatyat building which was provided for accomadation for the camp and the schedule for the week was prepared collectively. The volunteers were assigned their duties for the work to be done for the betterment of the villagers. After lunch hour the volunteers were introduced to the villagers and the visited the entire village learning more about the life of the village people. In the evening the students visited to the farm lands they enjoyed the beauty of the nature. The day closed with group discussion and dinner at night.

05.02.2020

On the second day of the NSS Camp the volunteers got up early morning practiced yoga and meditation. After breakfast we have carried out a survey in the entire village of Khanapur (Ibrahimpatnam). We have started survey in the morning and collected the data regarding the number of members in a family and also we have gathered the information about number of children especially girl child present in the family along with their education qualification, employed members, etc. We had a lovely interaction with the villagers and they received us with great hospitality and they were glad to share their information with us for their future development. The NSS volunteers prepared the lunch in the afternoon and dinner in the evening. Later, we had a great time playing native village games. It was so much fun knowing new activities and the interaction with the villagers was a memorable experience.

06.02.2020

On the third day of the NSS Camp we have carried out “SWACHH BHARAT” programme in Khanapur Village at appropriate places. All volunteers participated in this programme and showed much enthusiasm. The unwanted weeds, bushes and garbage in the surroundings were removed and made clean by the volunteers and the NSS volunteers collectively made an effort in

making the village a plastic free zone. Every day we had fall (together as contingent) in the morning at sharp 8.00 am and started with the prayer song, later the NSS Programme officer of Nizam College Unit III, Dr. Kavitha Ramdas addressed the contingent about the day schedule and assigned work to the volunteers with instructions. 07.02.2020

This NGO is mainly focused to create self employment for women by training them with various courses like tailoring, maggam work, beautician and computer training, etc. The chairperson of the NGO took a session for us about importance of self employment by skilled based works and providing women of this village Khanapur a proper living.

08.02.2020

On the fifth day of the NSS Camp we conducted a rally in the early morning hours around 7.00am in the entire village of Khanapur with a theme of environmental conservation, cleanliness, plastic free village, proper use and conservation of water and the NSS Volunteers have created awareness among the village about saving our mother nature. After lunch the NSS volunteers have visited Spoorthi Jyothi Foundation in the village where the students interacted with physically challenged people. The volunteers distributed fruits, biscuits, bread and some

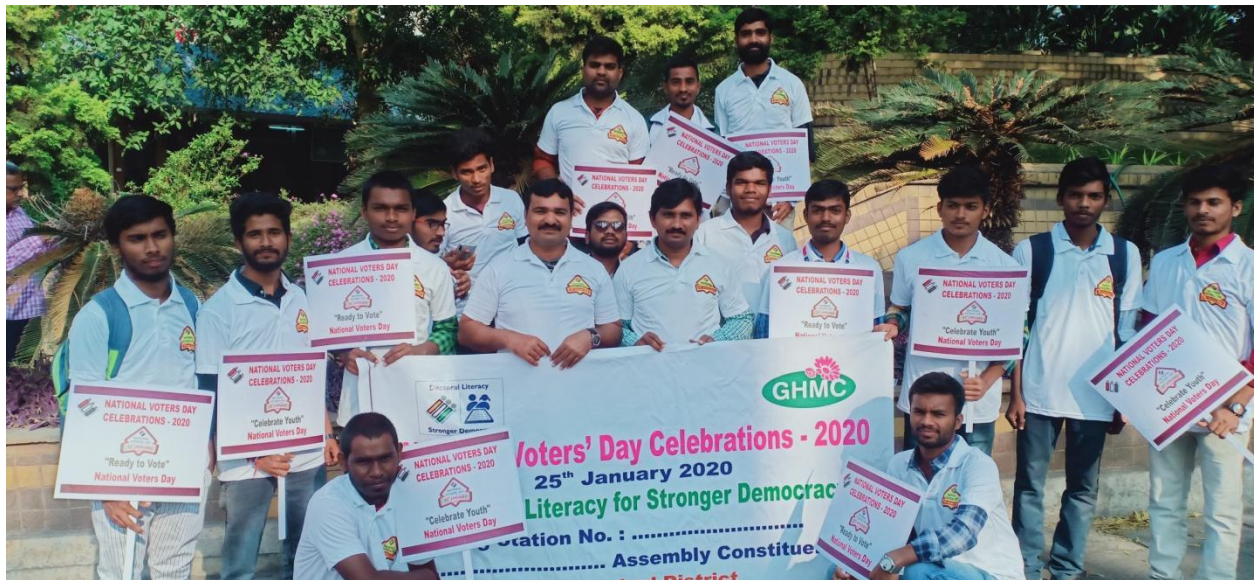
